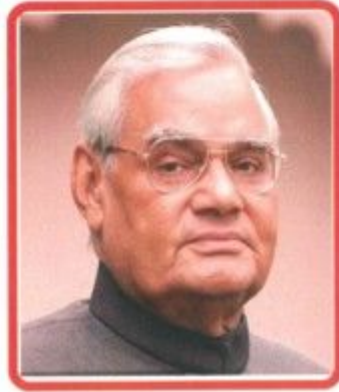

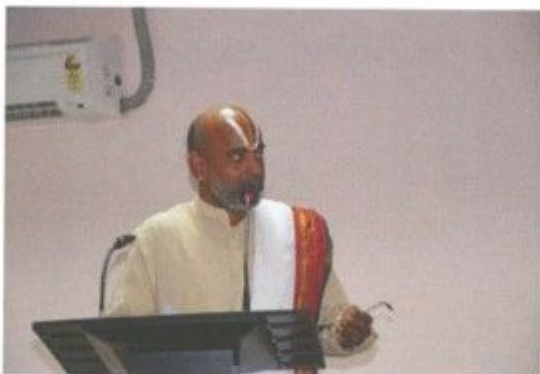

TIRUPATI: A two-day national seminar on 'Use of Technology and Innovation in Promoting Good Governance', organised by the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha's (RSVP) Vagvatihini Parishad, on the eve of 'Good Governance Day' (December 25), concluded here on Wednesday.

'Good Governance Day' is being observed to mark the birthday of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. As many as 25 students took part in the event and presented research papers on the topic besides participating in competitions on oratory (Bhasanam Shaleem).
